The Centre for Transnational Commercial Law at The National Law University, Delhi, supported by the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) and the UNCITRAL RCAP, in collaboration with INSOL India are happy to announce the 2021-22 International Moot Competition on Insolvency and Bankruptcy. The inaugural edition of the competition was held during 28-29th October 2017 at the National Law University, Delhi, India.

The theme of the 2021-22 edition is 'Cross- Border Insolvency'. Teams will be required to meet minimum threshold on the quality of submissions. In the oral rounds, teams will make the arguments on merits to industry experts acting as judges. The moot is being organised offline, the teams will be invited to NLUD for the oral rounds.
